Heidelberg School of Education

The Heidelberg School of Education (HSE) is the institutional, conceptual, and strategic center for the advancement of excellent and cooperative teacher education in Heidelberg, to which Heidelberg University and the Heidelberg University of Education contribute their outstanding expertise in the subject sciences, research-based subject didactics and the field of profession-related education. Digitization is a cross-sectional topic at the HSE that spans all spheres of work and action. The HSE oversees various measures to strengthen teacher education, which are implemented in the context of the joint projects heiEDUCATION 2.1 (*Qualitätsoffensive Lehrerbildung*) and PLACE (state funding). Since January 2019, the HSE has been in the process of establishing an analog-virtual "Digital Teaching and Learning Lab" as part of the project "HSE: Go digital! Now!".
